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SUPPLEMENTAL LANGUAGE ARTS AND MATHEMATICS LAB

Parent/Guardian Right to Request Removal from Title 1 Program

As a parent/guardian you have the right to request and to make statements in support of your child's removal from the program.

The following procedure should be followed:

1. Any parent/guardian expressing concern or dissatisfaction with their child's placement in the program must forward a written letter to the Superintendent/Principal/Title 1 Coordinator stating their concerns.
2. Once the written letter is received, the Superintendent/Principal/ Title 1 Coordinator shall contact the Supervisors of Math and ELA as well as the Guidance Supervisor to discuss the extent of the concern.
3. The Superintendent/Principal/Title 1 Coordinator will arrange a meeting with the parent/guardian to apprise the parent/guardian of the following:
 - a. Any student who does not meet minimum statewide proficiency levels shall be placed in compensatory programs.
 - b. The school district is responsible for providing appropriate improvement programs of instruction to adequately meet the identified educational needs of the student.
